Virginia Port Authority Board of Commissioners Executive Committee Meeting September 23, 2019

The Virginia Port Authority ("VPA") Executive Committee ("Committee") held a meeting on September 23, 2019, at Virginia Port Authority, 600 World Trade Center, 101 West Main Street, Norfolk, Virginia.

Motion for Closed Session
