MINUTES

Virginia Port Authority Board of Commissioners Search Committee Conference Call July 9, 2020

The Virginia Port Authority ("VPA") Executive/Search Committee ("Committee") held an electronic meeting on July 9, 2020.

This electronic meeting is assembled during a declared state of emergency when it is impracticable or unsafe to assemble a quorum in a single location, to discuss or transact the business statutorily required or necessary to continue operation of the public body in accordance with Item 4-0.01.g of Chapter 1283 of the 2020 Amendments to the 2019 Appropriation Act.

Chairman Milliken called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and asked Mrs. McNulty to conduct a roll call of the Search Committee who were on the call, as follows:

Motion to Convene an Electronic Meeting

At 9:00 a.m., Chairman Milliken made a motion to convene an electronic meeting pursuant to the requirements of Item 4-0.01.g of Chapter 1283 of the 2020 Amendments to the 2019 Appropriation Act, to discuss or transact the business statutorily required or necessary to continue operation of the Virginia Port Authority.
