Dr. Peter Anderson convened the meeting by Zoom at 9:03 a.m. Members present were Bobbie Potter, Craig Chancellor, Peter Anderson, Sarah Tolbert-Hurysz, Debbie Bond. Absent was Tosha Mosier.
