 - Charitable giving total in FY24 up 54% over FY23.
 - Combined charitable giving and museum earned revenue up 55% over FY23.
 - June 30, 2024 endowment balance up 11% over June 30, 2023 balance.
 - Number of VMNH Memberships up 7% over FY23.
 - Several recent, pending and upcoming grants and partnerships in support of mission-based programs and activities.
 - Recently awarded Virginia Tourism Grant in support of the July 2024 Dino Festival.
- Ryan Barber noted that funding partnerships are in place for festivals and major events scheduled through the end of 2025, enabling staff in partnership with the VMNH Foundation to secure grants and partnerships in support of these major festivals. Staff are working with the VMNH Foundation on 2026 partnerships.
