Additional Public Access Information:

Under §51.5-129 of the Code of Virginia, the State Rehabilitation Council (SRC) is established as a designated state council in the executive branch of government for the purpose of providing advice to and performing other functions for the Department of Aging and Rehabilitative Services regarding vocational services provided pursuant to Title I and Title VI of the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

The SRC is a public body that holds public meetings, pursuant to relevant provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). FOIA does not require in-person public meetings to be available to the public virtually. Although not required, some public bodies, including the SRC, currently make their meetings available virtually when possible.
